Support Meals at San Angelo Gives

San Anglo Gives is right around the corner and we are asking for your support again this year. Every year, we are deeply humbled and thankful for the gracious citizens of the Concho Valley and of our donors who continually support us in our mission.

Last year, San Angelo Gives raised over \$4.1 Million for over 200 non-profit organizations in the Concho Valley. The overall goal for this year is \$4.25 Million and you can help them achieve that goal through a donation to Meals For The Elderly on Tuesday, May, 2, 2023.

Every dollar you give on that day will go directly back to our organization to help pay for the food our recipients receive on a daily basis. Donations are also amplified thanks to donors who support the event. Last year, we delievered 254,766 meals to 1,071 unique individuals in our area. There are still people that need our support and services and we are hoping to provide 260,000 meals in 2023. This goal is only possible through the support of our donors and the generous community



we live in.

Last year, we had to increase our goal twice as the community came through and kept breaking it. We want to see the same thing happen again this year.
